- ❖ While reading a book underline those words with a pencil whose meaning you do not understand, later refer in a dictionary.

- ❖ Take up first the subject you most dislike; once you have done this, the rest of the work will be easy.
- ❖ Revise at the end of every week, all that you have learnt during the previous week.
- ❖ Do not hesitate to ask your teacher or your clever companions, things you do not grasp clearly. Never leave difficulties unanswered, as this will put you in greater difficulty later.

## **INFORMATION TO THE PARENT**

- ❖ Parents who seek information or wish to make some complaint shall do so to the Principal and not to the teacher.
- ❖ No gifts to the teacher is allowed without prior consent of the Principal.
- ❖ The entrusting of pupil to the school implies that the parents agree to abide by the rules, regulation and decisions of the school.
- ❖ Parents are requested to read the school rules carefully and see that they are followed.
- ❖ Parents are requested to attend the Parent – teachers meeting without fail and discuss with the teacher and principal regarding the students performance in the examinations. Your constructive suggestion will help our progress.
- ❖ Parents are requested to go through the various columns in the diary such as Appreciation, Remark, Late attendance record, Leave Record, Parent's request to teacher. Teacher's note to the parents, progress report etc.
- ❖ Encourage the child to converse in English at home.
- ❖ Parents are expected to affix their full signature at all time.
- ❖ Parents are sole responsible for the safety of their children before and after the school hours. Parents are expected to be on time to escort their children to home after the school time.
- ❖ When the Government or Department of Education announces and emergency / sudden holidays for schools due to administrative reasons, the school will not work on those days. No separate announcement from the school is mandatory.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- ❖ Children who have completed 3 years are eligible for admission to L.K.G and those who have completed 5 years are eligible for first standard admission.
- ❖ All the students should come to school in full school uniform, neat and tidy. Their hair should be well trimmed and combed and nails should be clipped properly.
- ❖ Pupils must be punctual to class. Late comers should get a written permission from the Principal/ Vice Principal
- ❖ No pupil should absent himself / herself without prior permission. For sick leaves (SL) leave letter should be sent to the school. For other planned leaves (L) they should apply in advance. If a leave letter is not submitted, Absent (Ab) will be marked. Parents should meet the Principal / Vice Principal.
- ❖ All the leave availed should be entered in the diary and the signature of parent and the class Teacher should be obtained.
- ❖ Parents or Relatives are not allowed to meet the pupils or the teachers during the school hours without the permission of the Principal. If necessary, they can meet the principal between 4.30 p.m to 6.00 p.m
- ❖ Students should take care of their belongings. They should not wear costly jewellery. The school will not be held responsible for the loss of any articles.
- ❖ Any damage caused to school property by a student has to be made good by the parent. Fine will be levied.
- ❖ Students should speak only in English inside the school campus.
- ❖ Students should bring the school diary to school.
